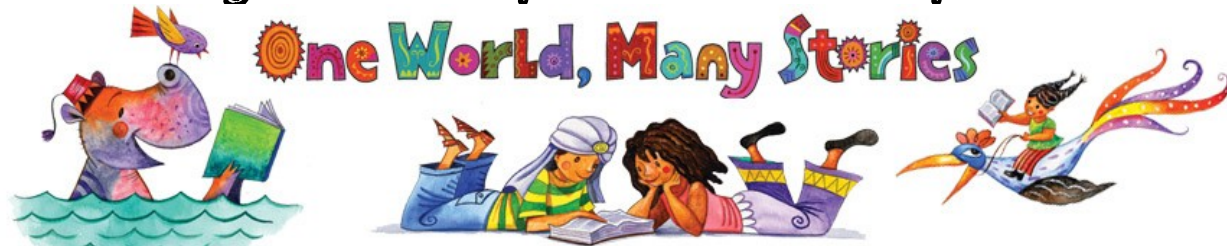


# Washington County Public Library Presents:



## Registration

Pre-Registration begins **May 31 – June 2** (Tuesday-Thursday). Complete the Registration form enclosed in this packet and return it to the Library. Additional forms will be available at the front desk and on our website [www.wcpls.org](http://www.wcpls.org). Several of our programs are age specific, require registration, or have limited space. Be sure to check our calendar for the age range of each event. We encourage you to register early to secure your child's spot for the activities listed at the bottom of the Registration form that require a reservation. All other activities are free throughout the summer and do not require a reservation. Children and Youth of all ages are encouraged to participate in events throughout the summer. Students entering grades K-12 do not require an accompanying adult. Pre-schoolers require Parent/Guardian participation during events.

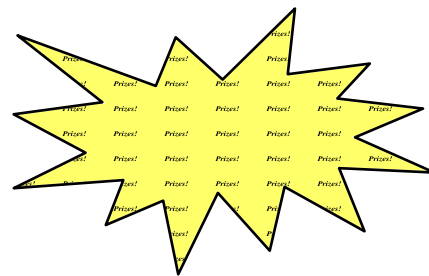
**Summer Kick-off Day is June 3rd!** Participants will be able to register, check out books and pick up all materials. An Australian Didgeridoo Musical group will be presenting Aboriginal Tribal Music and an exciting workshop for these exotic instruments after their performance! Join us from **9:00 - 11:30 am** for the kick-off of our Summer Reading Program!



**Read Around the World!** The more you read, the farther you travel around the globe in your hot air balloon! Be sure to check out and read books from our Library. Ask a Library Staff member to record your books on your Reading Log at the front desk each time you return them. As books are logged, the Big World Map will recognize levels of reading as your hot air balloon travels across the map. Once you reach 20 books, your balloon will be added! Below are the mileages for each goal reached:

**1,000 mile club: 20 Books ~ 10,000 mile club: 200 Books**  
**2,500 mile club: 50 Books ~ 15,000 mile club: 300 Books**  
**5,000 mile club: 100 Books ~ 25,000 mile club: 500 books**

To encourage participants to read all summer, there will be a **Grand Prize** drawing at the end of July! Every **five** books added on your Reading Log = another **entry** into the drawing. Keep reading throughout the summer and increase your chances of winning! Read Around the World!



**Field Trips** in June and July require reservation and are "First come, first served." A waiting list will be available once all spots are filled. Participants will receive further information regarding times and details about the trip. All Field Trip fees are due **June 10<sup>th</sup>** and **July 1<sup>st</sup>**.

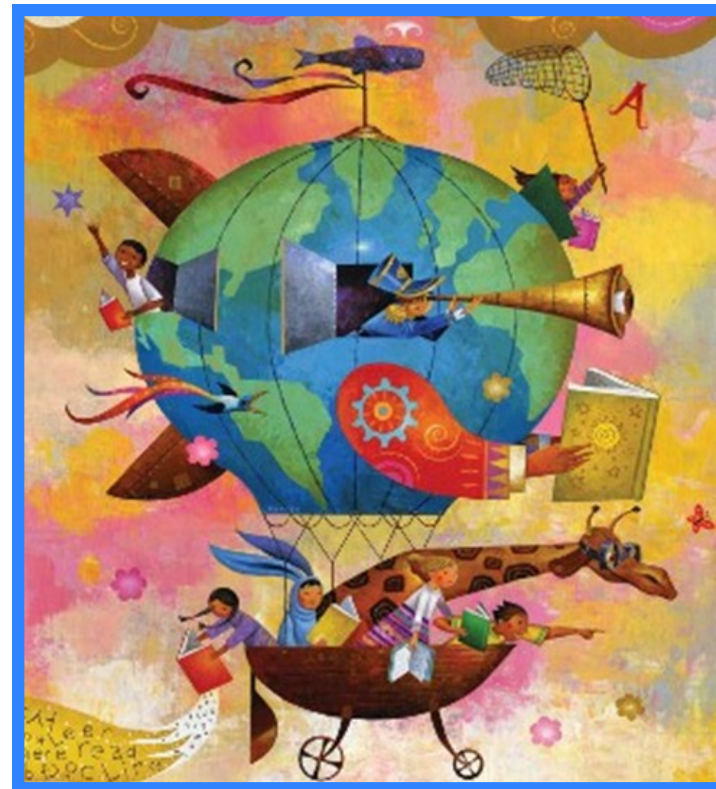
## Finale Party

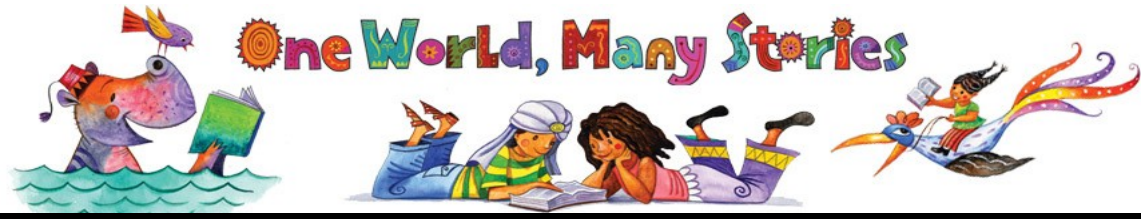

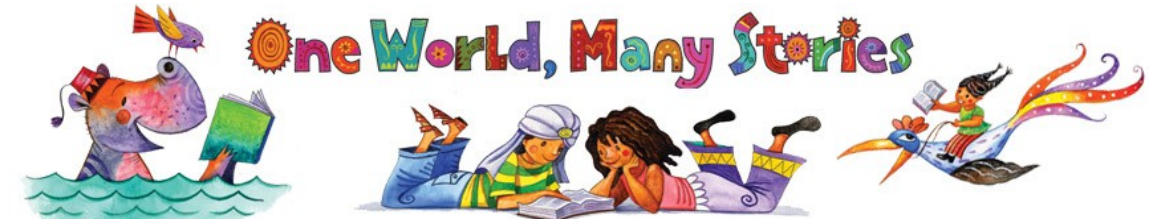
